

Solidarity with the person shot by the police at Rossmann!

No money and stealing soap or toothpaste from a drugstore?

Here, at Rossmann at the Hauptbanhof, this ended with a large-scale operation of the federal police, pepper spray and a shot the hand of a 15-year-old person!

This was worth only brief moment of media attention on 18. and 19.02.23. How the young person has been doing since then is not interesting enough. We assume that the cop who shot the person will not experience any consequences, because the system itself is violent.

Clear signals have been sent:

you must not resist, because the police have the weapons;

• and in this temple of consumption - called the Hauptbanhof - order has top priority. No matter what the cost. But the life of a young person is not worth much.

The rich are getting richer and richer, the poor are getting poorer and poorer, and the law enforcers are getting more and more brutal. The (worldwide) crisis and inflation also means rising authoritarianism and repression. Profits and the order that supports them must not be disturbed.

Rossmann itself - like other drugstore and food companies - is profiting from the crisis, while it is becoming increasingly difficult for many of us to buy their goods. According to its own figures, Rossmann had record sales of 12.15 billion euros in 2022, with sales growth of 9.5%. It is not the breadcrumbs that the government pays to its citizens, and that Rossmann or others pay to their employees as compensation for inflation that will fundamentally change our circumstances.

It is the well-known carrot-and-stick tactic: a few euros here so that it does not crash, and at the same time even more control, stricter legislation and police violence.

We from "der Preis ist heiß" are in solidarity with all those who take what they need and all those who are affected by police violence!
